

AVE MARIA KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS COUNCIL # 7880 2025 Scholarship Application Form

ELIGIBILITY

Any graduating high school senior who is a member of Ave Maria Parish, and who has been accepted by an accredited college, university or trade school as a full-time student, shall be eligible to apply for a scholarship given by Knights of Columbus Council 7880.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicants for a Knights of Columbus Scholarship shall be judged based on academic excellence, extracurricular activities (School, Community, and Church), and an Essay Question. A father's active membership in the Ave Maria Knights of Columbus Council will also be a consideration. The Selection Committee is made up of the three members of the Board of Trustees. The decision of the Selection Committee is final, and by submitting an application the applicant agrees to abide by their decision.

APPLICATION AND DOCUMENTATION

To be considered for a Knights of Columbus Scholarship, a graduating high school senior must:

- 1. Complete the prescribed application form. All questions must be answered completely.
- 2. Attach a certified transcript of his or her high school grades (see instructions).
- 3. Include a copy of a letter of acceptance from the college or university. If an acceptance letter is not available at the time of application, the Council must receive a copy of the letter of acceptance before making an award.
- 4. Deliver all documentation to the Committee not later than the announced date for application. Any application received after this date will not be considered.

WINNERS

There will be one male and one female winner selected from the entries. Applicants should submit an entry based on their God given gender. Each winner will receive not less than \$1000.00 (One Thousand dollars) for use towards tuition, books, fees or other related expenses. The winners will be announced following a review of all applications. If it is determined that two candidates in either the male or female groups are equal, the Committee reserves the right to split the \$1000 award as they feel is appropriate.
